


Hp thin client default password

Since the machines don't have great stickers on them with the default administrator password, I had to do some research. This post can save someone a few minutes. The default password for the Administrator account is the administrator. That's it. Can you provide a little more information? First of all, you will need an administrative account. You can use the Windows key to bring up the Start menu and you have to see the control panel there; if not, you can use the dialog box to find the control panel. Different thin customers use different (cut down) versions of the regular OS. In most cases, it still works in a similar way, slightly fewer options. I logged in as a local administrator, there is no system in the control panel. The Computer icon is not the right clickable - there is no contextual menu for selecting Properties or Management. There is no Netdom team. - Yes, I use an increased CMD request. Any other thoughts? Oh, my... That's what this is about. From an elevated team of clues, like a researcher. This results in the researcher's box, which lists both C and RAMDrive. Just by clicking on the start menu and the computer in the usual way, shows only RAMDrive. From there, you can right to press the Computer button and bring up the familiar Control Panel. Click Start.2. Holding the left shift key, click Log Off.3. However, by holding the left Shift key, click Log Off in the confirmation window. The Admin logo screen is displayed. NOTE: The default password for the Administrator account is the Administrator. The default username and password for User User. You's account can use HP Windows Logon Manager to permanently change the default login user. Located in the control panel, only the Administrator can access this application. -----Yw can also look into the HP Device Manager if you're going to deploy many of them. @OldSpice, thank you... Very much. The information will be useful for others. In fact, Thin Customers don't require a magic Shift key when logging in to the User system. I'm not sure if it's a 7E or a flexible slim customer thing, but an old XP logoff-shift isn't needed. Thank you for your advice. Maybe you don't quite understand me. I have a new slim client and I want to customize it from a local administrator. But I don't know the password from this user. It's not empty. By the way, how can I reset it?
